- Cross the Sydney Harbour Bridge travelling north.
- Join the M3 freeway travelling adjacent to the Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park, the second oldest National Park in Australia.
- Cross the picturesque Hawksbury River, noted for its Sydney Rock Oyster farming.
- Morning Tea at Wyong, home to early European Cedar timber cutters in the 1820s
- Pass through the town of Cessnock, servicing the population and coal mines of the region.
- Wine tastings at boutique wineries in Pokolbin, the centre of the wine producing region of the Hunter Valley.
- Chocolate or Cheese tasting at either the Hunter Valley Chocolate Company or Smelly Cheeses.
- Settle back in comfort for your return drive to Sydney.
