- Cross the Nepean River at the base of the Blue Mountains
- Commence the ascent to Katoomba on a scenic drive through historic towns including Blaxland, Lawson, Wentworth Falls and Leura.
- View the Three Sisters from Echo Point in the Jamison Valley.
- Visit Scenic World and ride both the 'Skyway' and the worlds steepest train the 'Scenic Railway' (added attraction)
- Walk through the temperate rain forest of the Jamison Valley - accessible by scenic railway.
- View the additional two spectacular valleys to the Jamison, the Megalong and Grose.
- Numerous low to high level graded scenic walks.
